



What do the poster boards look like?

Here are a few examples of what a police brutality **POSTER BOARDS** may look like. **POSTER BOARDS** can be painted, written or copied. You can use stickers, markers and additional items that will get the sign noticed. **POSTER BOARDS** will convey messages that address police brutality and racism. Boards should be specific to your issue as its important to get your word out for people to understand. Sizes can vary. Creativity is encouraged.



Where are the poster boards going?

- ▶ Poster boards should be placed on telephone poles, wood poles and street poles. Any place that will temporarily hold them.
- ▶ Poster boards will be placed where drivers, walkers, bus riders, bicycle riders can see them. However, we need to be careful and not create a hazard and/or obstruct view. Safety needs to be our first concern.
- ▶ Poster boards can be placed in your city, cities where police brutality has occurred or any city that you feel needs to be educated.



When will Poster Boards go up?

- ▶ The best time to put poster boards up is typically early morning during the week day.
- ▶ Monday- Friday from 7 am to 6 pm is the busiest times for road travel and more people will see your signs.
- ▶ The date of this national campaign will be TBA . Please mark your calendars.

How do I get this done?
